## PRODUCT INFORMATION

<b>Product Name:</b>	<b>MATT EMULSION</b>
<b>Reference Number:</b>	100-line.
<b>Coating Type:</b>	Acrylic emulsion.
<b>Typical Uses:</b>	High quality water-based paint for interior and exterior use on masonry, cement, plaster, concrete, asbestos, hardboard, timber, etc. Ideal for anaglypta and woodchip papers. The coating is hardwearing and scrub-resistant.
<b>Colours Available:</b>	The Vale Garden range of 24 colours.
<b>Appearance of Dried Film:</b>	Matt finish.
<b>Application rate:</b>	10-15m <sup>2</sup> per litre depending on porosity and texture of surface.
<b>Drying Time At 20°C: (Will Vary With Temperature, Air Movement etc.).</b>	<b>Touch Dry:</b> 1 hour. <b>Firm Dry:</b> 2-4 hours. <b>Overcoat:</b> 2-4 hours.
	<b>Note:</b> Drying times of emulsion paints will vary widely depending upon humidity, air circulation, ventilation, etc.
<b>Packaging:</b>	Sample tin, 2.5 litre and 5 litre containers
<b>Shelf Life:</b>	2 years or longer in unopened containers, when stored under cover in good storage conditions.
<b>Storage:</b>	Under cover within temperature range of 5°C to 32°C. Protect from frost.
<b>Surface Preparation:</b>	All surfaces must be clean, dry, and free from oil, grease, etc. Remove all loose, friable material, e.g. loose plaster, old flaking paint, etc. Loose, underbound or absorbent surfaces should be removed as far as possible to a firm edge and the first application of paint should be diluted with up to 30% water.
<b>Application:</b>	<b>Do not apply at temperatures below 5°C.</b>  May be applied by brush, roller, conventional or airless spray. Up to 15% of clean water may be added to achieve optimum spray characteristics.
<b>Thinning</b>	Clean water
<b>Clean-Up:</b>	Water and mild detergent – clean equipment <b>IMMEDIATELY</b> , do not allow emulsion to dry.
<b>Health and Safety:</b>	Please see relevant MSDS sheet.
